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The iCompete Tennis League gives the western suburbs junior tennis players a singular starting point into the world of competitive tennis!

iCompete Tennis League Features:

- New juniors competitive interclub league.
- Economical: \$30 for league through 8/31/2015, just \$25 per event.
- 4 rounds per event (approximately 2 hours) top scorers of the event go to playoffs.
- Players can feel accomplishment for earning points for games won even if they lose the match – every game counts.
- Champion and Finalist trophies are awarded at each event.
- Registration is first come, first served, rather than by ranking points. Sign up early.
- Points accumulate for the entire season and standings are updated after every match.
- Championship at the end of the season, champions advance to a regional competition. 2015 Regionals in Wisconsin!
- Good entry into competition or offers a chance to practice “aging up”.
- Participating clubs are in the western suburbs, travelling together is fun and cost-effective and matches all have similar starting times.

10s (Gender Neutral-Green Dot Ball),
12s (Gender Neutral),
Girls 15s and Boys 15s, and
Girls Open and Boys Open

How to Participate:

- 1) Sign up for the league by completing the iCompete League Membership form found on the website. Pay a league entry fee of just \$30, if by check made payable to iCompete. Payment may be made at any host site.
- 2) Sign up for each event using the iCompete Event Entry form found on the website and by emailing info@icompetetennis.com. You will receive a confirmation email. If less than 24 hours before an event we suggest you contact the host club to confirm your entry.
- 3) Bring cash or check (payable to iCompete) to the host site.

*** Division Notes:** You must age up to the next division at the start of your birthday month. For example, a 12s player is turning 13 years old on November 17th. Beginning November 1st he must sign up for 15s which is now separated by gender. Players may sign-up for older age divisions for a challenge, but they cannot play down. Players with a Midwest Ranking of 300 or better must play up one age division or in the Open Division.
